

## **Notes for Article submission**

IJPS is to disseminate information and facilitate understanding among persons concerned with political science. By publication of an academic journal in the field of political science, we just have some simple guidelines that we ask you to abide by. We welcome challenging articles, but allusive material will not be tolerated.

Contributors should follow the following guidelines.

1. Article must be written in English.
2. The content of the article must be unique, no rebranded articles are allowed.
3. The article in about 4000 words is welcomed, including the appendices.
4. Article must be related to political science, including international relations, political methodology, public policy and political thought, political sociology, political economy and comparative politics.
5. The article must not have been published previously or is not being published elsewhere.
6. The article must be typed in Times new roman 12 fonts with the single line spacing except the first paragraph, the other paragraphs should be indented 2.50 cm margins should be placed at the top, bottom and left of every page.
7. The title page should include full title(s) and affiliation(s) of the author(s) mail addresses and phone number(s) of the lead author. Title of the article should not exceed 50 words in length.
8. Abstract must include the full title and contain about 200 words.
9. Keywords must be related to the content of the article. They should all be in lower case letters followed by a comma and a space. The last keyword should have no punctuation after wards.
10. Reference box should be checked to ensure single line spacing between any two references. The second and the subsequent line should be indented.
11. Article of any subject matter we deem inappropriate will be declined.
